GEORGE WASHINGTON

president from **1789-1797**



- 1st president of the United States. Found on the \$1 bill!
- His dentures were made of lead, ivory, and animal and human teeth, NOT made of wood!
- He never cut down a cherry tree, that was only a story!
- He lost more battles than he won, but never gave up!

THOMAS JEFFERSON

president from **1801-1809**



- 3rd president of the United States. Found on the \$2 bill!
- He is most famous for being the main writer of the Declaration of Independence!
- Started the custom of shaking hands when greeting someone!
- He could speak five languages fluently!

ABRAHAM LINCOLN

president from **1861-1865**



- 16th president of the United States. Found on the \$5 bill!
- Gave one of the greatest speeches in history, the Gettysburg Address, honoring soldiers who fought the Battle of Gettysburg.
- He worked hard to keep the country united and end slavery!
- At 6 feet 4 inches, he was the tallest president in history!

THEODORE ROOSEVELT

president from **1901-1909**



- 26th president of the United States. Not on any currency!
- He had a pet guinea pig named Father O'Grady and a pet snake named Emily Spinach!
- He was the first American to win the Nobel Peace Prize!
- The teddy bear was named after him!

FUN FACTS

- 1.** The carving of Mount Rushmore began in 1927 and finished in 1941.
- 2.** The actual carving was done by a team of over 400 men.
- 3.** Each president's face is 60 feet high.
- 4.** The faces appear in the order: Washington, Jefferson, Roosevelt, Lincoln.
- 5.** Jefferson was originally intended to be on Washington's right.
- 6.** The carving was originally meant to include the bodies of the presidents down to their waists.
- 7.** Mount Rushmore once had an amateur baseball team.
- 8.** 90% of the mountain was carved with dynamite, and more than 450,000 tons of rock was removed.
- 9.** South Dakota's official nickname is the Mount Rushmore State.
- 10.** Some believe you can see an elephant if you look to the right of Lincoln.
- 11.** Mount Rushmore is granite, which erodes roughly 1 inch every 10,000 years.
- 12.** Mount Rushmore is now visited by nearly 3 million people each year.
